"Swachhata Hi Seva" Pakhwara (Sept. 15 to Oct. 2, 2018) Consolidated Report

Taking one more step towards fulfilling the Mahatma Gandhi's dream of a clean and hygienic India by 150th birth anniversary in 2019, ICAR-National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases started the celebration of 'Swachhata Hi Seva' pakhwara with a pledge for cleanliness administered by the Director, ICAR-NIHSAD to all the employees. During the pakhwara, we carried out several activities as prescribed by the Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation. We organized a waste collection drive at tourist places, including Hathai Kheda Lake and Mahadev Pani and created awareness on sanitation, hygiene and proper waste disposal to visitors in improving the overall health of human, animals, soil and ecosystem. Our institute, NIHSAD in collaboration with "iClean, Bhopal", a non-government organization, painted the institute wall with special theme of swachhata. Even the passersby showed their interest in painting the institute wall and expressed their great art on it. We also organized awareness campaigns around better sanitation practices like using a toilet, hand washing, health and hygiene awareness etc. in two villages namely Kokta and Pathar villages, Bhopal where school students and residents were given tips on hygiene and sanitation, and role of cleaning the hand in a correct way was also demonstrated. The children also performed hand-cleaning exercise on the spot. The soaps and hand-napkins were distributed among the children. Tree plantations were also carried out in in the ground area of the school. The villagers from the Pathar and Kokta villages were invited to the campus and first-hand information about the points to be remembered while construction of a toilet was communicated in the form of an audiovisual aid. Besides, we also mobilized community to build compost pits, where organic matter decomposes to form manure and importance of segregation of solid waste into non-biodegradable and biodegradable waste to the institute staff and also to the residents of Ishaan Park, Bhopal. On the concluding day (Oct. 2), we performed a special cleanliness drive at Hathai Kheda Lake, Bhopal. This location is famous for ganpati visarjan. The huge debris accumulated post-ganpati visarjan was cleaned by the dedicated team of the institute. The non-biodegradable waste like plastic, glass and scrap materials were also collected and disposed of properly. After the cleaning of this lake, a lecture on '10 steps in making Swachh Bharat' was delivered by Dr. HV Murugkar, Principal scientist, NIHSAD in the auditorium. The activities carried during the 'Swachhata Hi Seva' Pakhwara (Sept. 15- Oct. 2, 2018) were briefed to all the staff of the institute.
