

Inauguration of Hands-on Training on Emerging Animal Disease Diagnosis

A training programme titled 'Hands-on Training on Emerging Animal Disease Diagnosis' funded by DBT-NER-Advanced Animal Diseases Diagnosis and Management Consortium (ADMaC) project was inaugurated by Dr. V.
