

ICAR-Jawaharlal Nehru award for scientist from ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal

The 91st Foundation Day of ICAR and Award Ceremony was held on 16th July 2019 at National Agricultural Science Centre Complex, New Delhi. During this ceremony, Dr. Senthil kumar D., Scientist from ICAR- National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases, Bhopal was presented Jawaharlal Nehru Award for P.G. Outstanding Doctoral Thesis Research in Agricultural and Allied Sciences - 2018 in Animal Science category by Dr. Trilochan Mohapatra, Secretary (DARE) and DG (ICAR) and Dr. Panjab Singh, Former Director General, ICAR & President, NAAS. This prestigious award carries a citation, a gold plated medal and a cash prize of Rs. 50,000 and is awarded by ICAR to promote high quality doctoral thesis research in priority/frontier areas of agriculture and allied sciences.
