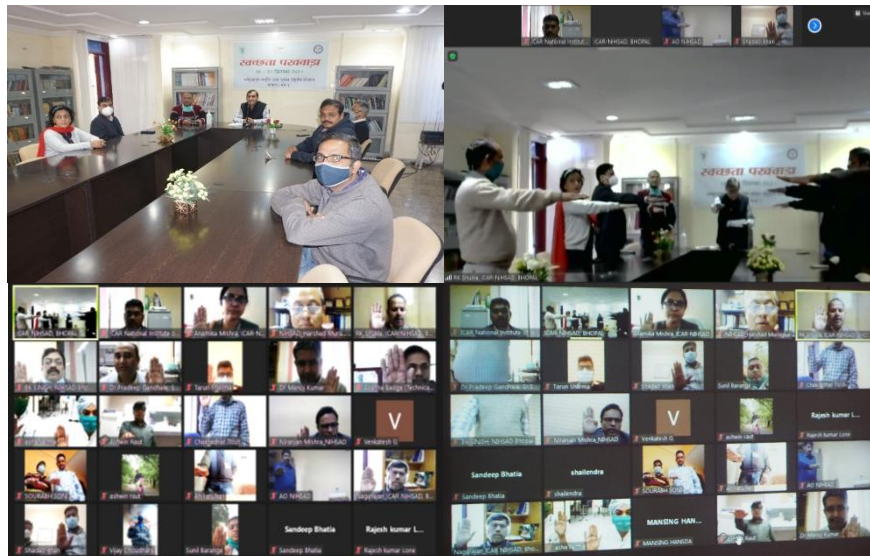


“Swachhta Pakhwada” Celebration at ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal (Dec. 16, 2021)
