

“Swachhta Pakhwada” Celebration at ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal (Dec. 25, 2021)

A cleanliness and awareness activity was conducted at a tourist attraction, Kankali Mandir in Bhopal, which is one of the state's oldest temples and is frequently visited by the devotees.
