

Celebration of “Swachhta of nearby tourist spot (01.10.17)”

ICAR-National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases, Bhopal celebrated the “Swachhta of nearby tourist spot” as part of “Swachhta Hi Seva” campaign on Oct. 1, 2017. For this special activity, Hathai kheda lake, a under-developed tourist spot was selected because it is more prone to huge garbage collection especially on the occasion of Durga Visarjan puja during Navratri. All the staff of the institute including the scientists, technical, administrative, research (RA, SRF, JRF, PA and students), supporting and contractual staff gathered at the shore of the lake at 08:00 AM and contributed more than 2.0 hours passionately in cleaning. A huge amount of garbage which included plastic bags, scrap materials, glass, flower garland, idols etc. were pulled out from the shore of the lake and loaded in the institute tractor for its disposal. The Bhopal Municipal Corporation also helped us in the proper disposal of tons of garbage.
