

Observation of Vigilance Awareness Week, 2018 at ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal (29.10.18 to 03.11.18)

The Vigilance Awareness Week was observed at ICAR-National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases (NIHSAD), Bhopal from 29th October to 3rd November, 2018. The week began with administration of the Integrity pledge to 73 persons (employees, customers, citizens and students) of the Institute by Dr. V.P. Singh, Director, NIHSAD, Bhopal, on 29th October at 11.00 AM in the Institute auditorium. In his opening remarks, Dr. Niranjan Mishra, Vigilance officer of NIHSAD stressed upon the importance of transparency, punctuality, conduct and integrity at all working levels of staff and public for effective implementation of preventive vigilance and about this year's theme: Eradicate corruption and build a new India. The Director emphasized to inculcate moral values among staff, contractual workers and all sections of the society so that corruption at all levels can be minimized and our country can progress at a rapid pace and advocated that the fight against corruption should involve active involvement of all the citizens of the country and active vigilance by all concerned. He stressed upon the importance of sincerity, integrity, sensitivity and impartiality for preventing corruption in public life. Banners and posters depicting vigilance awareness and corruption in public life were displayed prominently at several locations of the Institute. A debate competition was organized on 3rd November on the topic: Eradicate corruption and build a new India, in which nine participants expressed their views and two awardees were selected by a judging committee. All the staff of the Institute actively participated in the vigilance awareness program.
