Online Tender are hereby invited on behalf of the Director, ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal for COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF BIO-MEDICALWASTE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR ON JOB/WORK CONTRACT BASIS AT ICAR-NIHSAD, BHOPAL AND EXTENDABLE BY ONE/TWO MORE YEAR SUBJECT TO SATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE OF THE VENDOR AND MUTUAL AGREEMENT.

1. The terms and conditions of the contract are those contained in the general conditions of contract applicable to the contracts placed by the ICAR-NIHSAD as detailed in the tender forms. Please submit your rates in the tenders form if you are in a position to furnish the requisite services in accordance with the requirements stated in the attached **Annexures**.
2. Earnest money of Rs. 10, 000/- must be deposited in the form of demand draft/FDR to ICAR Unit, NIHSAD, Bhopal **in person to Director, ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal on or before the last date/time of submission**. The particulars of the earnest money deposited must also be superscribed on the top of the envelope by including the deemed draft/FDR number and date failing which the bids will not be accepted. Conditional bids shall not be considered. No overwriting or cutting is permitted in the tender documents. Such bids will be rejected outright.
3. The tenderer is being permitted to give tenders in consideration of the stipulations on his part that after submitting his tenders, he will not resile from his offer or modify the terms and conditions thereof. If the tenderer fails to observe and comply with the foregoing stipulations, the aforesaid amount of EMD will be forfeited by the NIHSAD. In the event of the offer made by the tenderer not being accepted, the amount of earnest money deposited by the tenderer will be refunded to him after he has applied for the same, in the manner prescribed by the ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal. An undertaking as per Annexure A-1 (Section – 7), is also required to be submitted by the tendering firm.
4. The schedules of the tender form should be uploaded with online technical bids. In the event of

the space provided on the schedule from being insufficient for the required purposes, additional pages may be added. Each additional page must be numbered consecutively and be signed in full by the tenderer. In such cases, reference to the additional pages must be made in the tender form. If any modification of the schedule is considered necessary it should be communicated by means of a separate letter alongwith the tenders.

5. The tenders are liable to be ignored if complete information as required is not given therein or if the particulars asked for in the **annexures** to the tenders are not fully filled in. Individual signing the tenders or other documents connected with the contract may specify whether he signs it in the capacity of (i) a sole proprietor of the firm or constituted attorney of such sole proprietor, or (ii) a partner of the firm if it be partnership in which case he must have authority to refer to arbitration dispute concerning the partnership whether by virtue of the partnership agreement or power of attorney or (iii) constituted attorney of the firm if it is a company.
6. If a tenderer does not accept the offer, after issue of letter of award by ICAR-NIHSAD within 15 (Fifteen) days, the offer made shall be deemed to be withdrawn without any notice & earnest money forfeited.
7. In case of partnership firms, where no authority has been given to any partner to execute the contract/agreement concerning the business of the partnership, the tenders and all other related document must be signed by every partner of the firm. A person signing the tender form or any other documents forming part of the contract on behalf of another shall be deemed to warrant that he has authority to bind such other and if, on enquiry it appears that the persons so signing had no authority to do so, the ICAR-NIHSAD shall without prejudice to other civil and criminal remedies, cancel the contract and hold the signatory liable for all costs and damages. Each page of the tender and the schedules to the tender and annexure(s), if any, should be signed by the tenderer and should be uploaded alongwith technical bid.
8. Online tenders are invited under two-bids systems through e-procurement system. **EMD must be deposited with Director, ICAR-NIHSAD during working hours i.e. 10:00AM to 5:00 PM on all working days (except Saturday, Sunday and Gazetted Holidays) before the last date/time for submission of bids, failing which bids will not be accepted. EMD must be in the form of Demand draft/FDR in favour of ICAR Unit, NIHSAD, Bhopal.**
9. Tenders will be opened online by the authorized officer(s) on 01.08.2022 at 11:30 AM. Bidders have two options to participate in tendering process at the time of opening of Bids. Bidders can come at the place of opening of bids (electronically) as done in the conventional tender process or he can visualize the process online without physically being present at ICAR-NIHSAD.
10. The financial bid (BOQ) will be opened for the technically qualified tenderers only. The date of opening of financial bid would be intimated to technically qualified tenderers.
11. Tenderer is at liberty to be present or to authorize a representative to be present at the time of opening of the tenders. The name and address of the representative who would be attending the opening of the tenders on your behalf should be indicated in your tender. Name and address of permanent representative of the tenderer, if any, may also be indicated.
12. An amount equivalent to 3% of the total contract value of contract or amount as decided is to be deposited by the selected agency/successful tenderer as Performance Security Deposit only after receiving a communication from the NIHSAD. In the event of non-deposition of the same, the earnest money will be forfeited.
13. No interest on security deposit and earnest money deposit shall be paid by the NIHSAD to the tenderer.
14. The bid validity period is **180 days** from the date of opening of technical bid.
15. The GST or any other tax which is as per the rules of the Government shall be deducted at source from monthly bill of the successful tenderer, as per rules/instructions made applicable from time to time by government.
16. Decision of Director, ICAR-NIHSAD shall be final for any aspect of the contract and binding on

- all parties. Disputes arising, if any, on the contract will be settled at his level by mutual consultation and in case of failure of settlement, dispute shall be referred to the sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Director, ICAR-NIHSAD. The decision of the sole arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding on the parties. Arbitration proceeding shall be governed by the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 196 as amended from time to time.
17. Acceptance by the Director, ICAR-NIHSAD will be communicated by fax/express letter or any other form of communication. Formal letter of acceptance and work order of the tenderer will be forwarded as soon as possible, but the earlier instructions in the fax/express letter etc. should be acted upon immediately.
  18. The Director, ICAR-NIHSAD does not pledge itself to accept the lowest or any tenders and also reserve to itself right of accepting the tenders whole or in part keeping in view valid reasons. Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
  19. Successful Bidder/tenderer will have to enter into a detailed contract agreement with ICAR-NIHSAD on **non-judicial stamp paper of 3% value of Total contract cost (subject to condition that minimum value of stamp will be Rs. 500.00 and maximum value of stamp will be Rs. 25,000/-)** or appropriate value as per Rules in force.

### **SECTION 3: - INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS**

#### **A. SUBMISSION OF OFFER:**

1. Tender should be submitted only through E-Procurement.
2. Tender must be submitted in Two bid system. (Technical & Financial).
3. Price bid/BOQ must be submitted through E-Procurement.
4. Quoting of Price (s): Price quoted should be in Indian Rupees, free pick up & delivery at ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal.
5. Price must be inclusive of all taxes.
6. Any bidder currently engaged in litigation with other Organization, must inform their status in writing.
7. Communication with bidders will be carried out electronically and/or in hard copy. All bidders must provide their current E-mail address.

#### **B. COST OF BIDDING:**

1. The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid and the Purchaser shall not be responsible or liable for those costs.

#### **C. VALIDITY OF THE BID: 180 Days from the date of submission of bid.**

#### **D. AMENDMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS:**

1. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal, for any reason, whether on its own initiative or in response to the clarification request by a prospective BIDDER may modify the bid document.

#### **E. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS:**

#### **F. BID OPENING PROCESS:**

1. The Technical Bid will be opened in the first instance.
2. Financial bids of only those bidders, whose bids are found technically qualified, by the Technical Evaluation Committee, will be opened.

#### **G. CONFIDENTIALITY:**

1. Information relating to the evaluation of Bids, and recommendation of Contract award, shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until information on Contract award is communicated to all Bidders.
2. Any attempt by a Bidder to influence the Purchaser in the evaluation of the Bids or Contract award decisions may result in the rejection of its Bid.
3. Notwithstanding, from the time of Bid opening to the time of Contract award, if any Bidder wishes to contact the Purchaser on any matter related to the bidding process, it shall do so in writing.

#### **H. DEVIATION, RESERVATIONS AND OMISSIONS:**

1. During the evaluation of Bids, the following definitions apply:
  - (a) "Deviation" is a departure from the requirements specified in the Bidding Document;
  - (b) "Reservation" is the setting of limiting conditions or withholding from complete acceptance of the requirements specified in the Bidding Document;

- (c) “Omission” is the failure to submit part or all the information or documentation required in the Bidding Documents.

**I. EVALUATION OF BID:**

1. ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal evaluate technical and Price acceptable offers on landed net price basis.
2. Offer which deviates from the vital conditions (as illustrates below) of the tender shall be rejected:
  - (a) Non-submission of complete offers.
  - (b) Receipt of offers without e-procurement system.
  - (c) Receipt of offers in open conditions.
3. In case any Bidder is silent on any clauses mentioned in this tender documents, ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal shall construe that the Bidder had accepted the clauses as per the invitation to tender no further claim will be entertained.
4. No revision in the terms and conditions quoted in the offer will be entertained.
5. In case of two bid system the date and time of Price Bid Opening shall be intimated to technically qualifying bidders through **e-procurement portal** <http://eprocure.gov.in/www.nihsad.nic.in>.

**J. PRICE BID:**

1. Quoting of Price (s): Price quoted should be in Indian Rupees.
2. Price Bid/BOQ through e-procurement.
3. Tender will be taken as inclusive of all Taxes, if nothing is stated by the firm.

**K. TRANSFER AND SUBLETING:**

1. The seller shall not sublet, transfer, assign or otherwise part with the acceptance to the tender or any part thereof, either directly or indirectly, without the prior written permission of the Purchaser.

**L. CANCELLATION OF TENDER:**

1. Notwithstanding anything specified in this tender document, ICAR-NIHSAD in his sole discretion, unconditionally assigning any reasons, reserve the rights:
  - (a) To accept OR reject lowest tender.

**M. DELIVERY.**

The successful BIDDER should deliver the material as per tender document/purchase order.

#### **SECTION – 4 – TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Incidental charges, if any, will be borne by the firm/services provider. Similarly any loss on transit will be sole responsibility of the firm/service provider.
2. The EMD of Rs. 10,000/- must be deposited in the form of Demand Draft/FDR in favour of ICAR Unit, NIHSAD, Bhopal.
3. All charges including GST any other levies payable by ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal should be clearly indicated as per BOQ otherwise it would be presumed that the rates quoted are inclusive of all these charges and will not be paid.
4. Before award of order/Authorization for collection and disposal of Bio-Medical Waste, the successful bidder/tenderer will have to enter into a detailed contract agreement with ICAR-NIHSAD on **non-judicial stamp paper of 3% value of Total contract cost (subject to condition that minimum value of stamp will be Rs. 500.00 and maximum value of stamp will be Rs. 25,000/-)** or appropriate value as per Rules inforce. Non-compliance of these terms and conditions shall be liable to forfeiture of the security money or black listing of the firm for dealing in future or both or any other action as deemed fit with the approval of Director, NIHSAD and decision in this regard shall be final.
5. In case of not attending the job/absence, a prorata deduction will be made from the billing amount.
6. This is a comprehensive Contract for lifting of waste. Hence, all job (lifting & disposal etc.) is in scope of the agency/firm.
7. Rates will not be revised/increased in future without written consent of the Director/Competent Authority of NIHSAD, Bhopal.
8. Lifting of waste will be done between 10 AM to 5 PM on regular basis (without any break).
9. No payment will be made in advance even through Bank. But the payment will be released within 30 days through the mode of E-Payment only after raising the proper bill mentioning GST number (Institute & Firm's) and completion of full month. Triplicate pre-receipted bills duly revenue stamped, wherever required should be sent to the concerned Division for payment.
10. Entry & Exit of Agency Vehicle/Lorry will be made both at ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal main gate/concerned In-charge.
11. Any dispute arises will be referred to the Director, ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal for sole arbitration and decision thereof and shall be final and binding upon both the parties.
12. No payment will be made for unsatisfactory services.
13. The firm will have to sign an agreement with ICAR- NIHSAD, Bhopal within 10 days of the letter of approval from the Director, ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal.
14. The Director, ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal reserve the right to cancel the authorization at any time without assigning reason.
15. The Competent Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the proposals without assigning any reasons.

**SECTION – 6 – TECHNICAL BID****Technical Specifications for Collection and Disposal of Bio-Medical Waste at NIHSAD, Bhopal**

1. Approximate Average monthly generation of biomedical waste to be collected by Central Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) for the Institute is approximately 480-500kg/month. However, the quantity may vary on day to day basis and the firm will absorb the minor increase in the quantity of BMW within the quoted rates.
2. The contractor should have valid authorization from Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Authorities to carry out the handling, reception, storage, transport, treatment and disposal of Bio-Medical Waste in Bhopal, throughout the period of contract including extended period on mutual agreement if any.
3. The selected firm shall be responsible for the handling, reception, transport and disposal of biomedical waste from the institute's laboratories. It shall be the legal duty of the firm to ensure that biomedical waste is collected, transported and disposed in such a manner that they do not cause any adverse impact on human and animal health or environment, as per the provision of Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rule 2016.
4. Sites where the different categories of bio-medical waste is generated would include, but may not necessarily be limited to, all the laboratories inside and outside the containment laboratory and containment animal wing.
5. The Contractor shall collect the segregated bags of waste from the pre-determined collection points daily except on holidays at predetermined time in special vehicle approved by MP Pollution Control Board (MPPCB) as per Rules. The CBWTF provider will accept & collect the segregated bags collected from the Bio-Medical Waste Storage rooms shall be weighed by the representative of the contractor in presence of authorized laboratory representative.
6. The firm must provide a register and should maintain a daily record of all the waste collected in terms category and colour coding as specified in Schedule I of Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rule 2016. Representative of the CBWTF provider shall sign the 'Daily Collection Sheet' in token of acknowledgement of quantity of waste received.
7. All legal responsibility of Bio-Medical Waste treatment shall be of the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) provider immediately after it being picked up from the storage rooms.
8. If any violation of rules happens during transit, all responsibility shall be that of the CBWTF provider.
9. Irrespective of shut down/break down of the plant/incinerator/CTF, it will be the responsibility of the CBWTF provide to collect Bio-Medical Waste from all Bio-Medical Waste storage rooms every day.
10. The CBWTF provider shall be responsible for any punitive legal action arising out of non-lifting/non-collection and non-disposal of Bio-Medical Waste from ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal.
11. In case of breakdown, if disposal is not done within 48 hrs (as per rules & regulations of Bio-Medical Waste Management & Handling) Rule, 2016, all legal responsibility shall be

- that of the CBWTF Service provider.
12. Collection of Bio-Medical Waste will be undertaken daily. In case of default, no payment shall be made for that particular day(s). Besides, there would be an additional penalty amounting to 1% of the monthly payment if Bio-Medical Waste is not picked up from ICAR-NIHSAD for duration of 48-72 hours and 2% of the monthly payment for every additional day of failure to pick up.
  13. All bio-medical waste must be treated or disposed off within 48 hours of it being generated.
  14. The CBWTF provider shall transport the Bio-Medical Waste in a dedicated covered vehicle to an authorized waste treatment Entity which is duly authorized by MPPCB and meets the requirements of Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rule, 2016.
  15. It would be the inescapable duty of the CBWTF provider to ensure that the instruments and practices used for the treatment and disposal of the waste comply with the standards prescribed in Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2016. ICAR-NIHSAD would be free to inspect the site and check documentary evidence to that effect from time to time.
  16. The CBWTF provider would be required to assist ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal in filling annual reports and other reports/records as mandated by the appropriate pollution control authorities from time to time.
  17. The CBWTF provider shall be open for inspection of its waste treatment and disposal facilities by a designated team of ICAR-NIHSAD, in order to ascertain its compliance with the provisions mentioned in Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2016.
  18. The CBWTF provider shall be required to establish bar coding and global positioning system (GPS) for handling of Bio-Medical Waste and to share the GPS coordinates with the first party.
  19. The CBWTF provider shall have to provide training for all its workers involved in handling of Bio-Medical Waste at the time of induction and at least once a year thereafter.
  20. The CBWTF provider will need to undertake appropriate medical examination at the time of induction and at least once in a year and immunize all its workers involved in handling of bio-medical waste for protection against diseases, including Hepatitis B and Tetanus, that are likely to be transmitted while handling Bio-Medical Waste and maintain the records for the same.
  21. The CBWTF provider will also be responsible for ensuring occupational safety of all its workers involved in handling of Bio-Medical Waste by providing appropriate and adequate personal protective equipment.
  22. The CBWTF provider will quote their monthly rates/prices inclusive of all taxes and expenditure.
  23. The monthly payment on the basis of waste generated will be verified by the ICAR-NIHSAD, Bhopal Administration.
